

A DIVERSE NETWORK OF LEADERS



A study by University of New Hampshire and Sightlines found that Carbon Commitment signatories have **47%** lower carbon emissions from purchased energy than non-signatories



The Climate Leadership Network currently represents **35.7%** of all higher education students in the U.S. and **18.9%** of U.S. higher education institutions

Minority-Serving Institutions make up **28.8%** of all Higher Ed, but represent **36.4%** of the Climate Leadership Network

The Climate Leadership Network schools make up a significant portion of top sustainability rankings, for example:

84% of the Princeton Review Top 50 green schools

100% of the Top 10 Sierra Club Cool Schools
