

Davarian L. Baldwin is the Paul E. Raether Distinguished Professor of American Studies and founding director of the Smart Cities Lab at Trinity College (CT). He is the author of *In the Shadow of the Ivory Tower: How Universities are Plundering Our Cities*; *Chicago's New Negroes: Modernity, the Great Migration, and Black Urban Life*, and coeditor (with Minkah Makalani) of the essay collection *Escape From New York! The New Negro Renaissance beyond Harlem*. Baldwin serves as a Distinguished Lecturer for the Organization of American Historians and his opinions and commentaries have been featured in numerous outlets from NBC News, PBS, and The History Channel to *USAToday*, the *Washington Post* and *TIME*.
